Construction


The diaphragm seal is made of a collar with connection piece for the measuring instrument, and a short extension tube to which the diaphragm is flush welded.

A filling port at the connection piece for the measuring instrument is provided for filling the complete measuring system after mounting and evacuation.

An attachment flange is used for mounting the diaphragm seal to the measuring point.



Do not open any connection of the system! Otherwise filling fluid will leak out and the measuring system cannot work proper anymore!


